



**CITY OF MENASHA RECOMMENDATIONS
SUPERSEDING SAFER AT HOME ORDER**

This Order shall supersede the City of Menasha's Safer at Home Order previously enacted on May 14, 2020. I am issuing the following recommendations to serve as guidelines to control the transmission of the COVID-19 virus throughout our community effective May 15, 2020 at 5:00 P.M.

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 252.03(1) and (2), the undersigned Health Officer recommends the following within the City of Menasha:

Businesses, non-profits, and other entities may open provided they are able to follow the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) recommendations for their sector. The guidelines can be found here: <https://wedc.org/reopen-guidelines/>

Individuals and families continue practicing physical distancing and protective measures outlined on the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (WI DHS) website: <https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/covid-19/protect.htm>

Enforcement: These guidelines provide recommendations and do not provide for enforcement.

Duration: This communication shall become effective at 5:00 P.M., May 15th and shall remain in effect until revoked or superseded by subsequent recommendations or order.

As the local health officer for the City of Menasha, I further recognize that this situation may continue to evolve and may require future orders to protect the public's health and safety.
