



City of Menasha COVID-19 Data Summary

Date: May 11, 2023

Highlights

The Federal Public Health Emergency (PHE) declaration is set to end today, May 11, 2023. This means that **this data summary is the final data summary the Menasha Health Department will publish.** COVID-19 will continue to be monitored as other respiratory viruses are, but outside emergency response mode. Key details following the end of the PHE:

- [Say Yes! COVID Test](#) program will remain in effect through the end of May. Individuals who are insured by Medicare, Medicaid/CHIP can still receive COVID tests for free. Those who are insured by private insurance should check with their insurance provider about test coverage.
- People covered under Medicaid will be able to access at-home tests for free through September 2024.
- WI DHS's [COVID-19 Treatment Telehealth Program](#) has been extended to December 31, 2023.
- COVID-19 vaccines will remain free, as long as Federal COVID-19 vaccine supply lasts. COVID-19 vaccines authorized under Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) are still available. After the Federal supply is depleted, there may be a charge associated with COVID-19 vaccination. For the latest COVID-19 vaccine recommendations, visit [this website](#).

To help prevent the spread of the virus, follow current [isolation](#) and [quarantine](#) guidance if you test positive for COVID-19, have symptoms, or have been exposed.

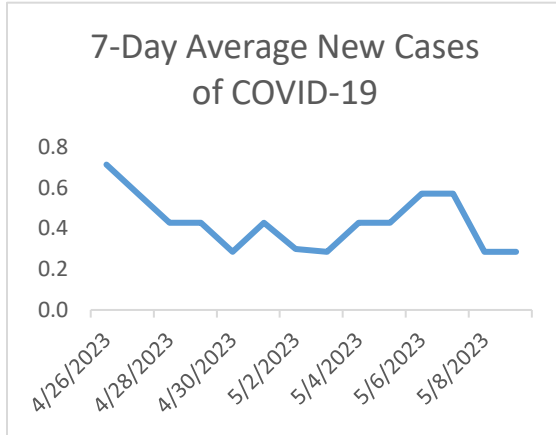

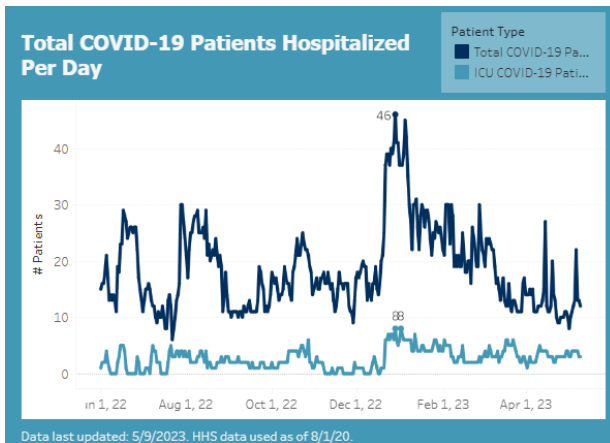
