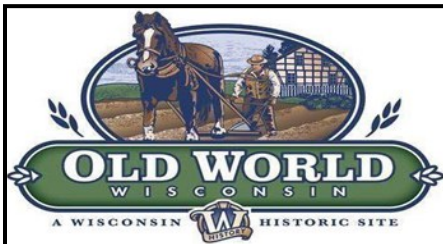

Old World Wisconsin and East Troy Train Ride

Head to Eagle to explore the Historic Old World Wisconsin and experience the lives of Midwest immigrants. And, enjoy a 90-minute scenic ride aboard the restored East Troy Train.

Friday, August 16, 2024



- Old World Wisconsin is the second largest outdoor museum of rural life in the US. This open-air museum is a fun way to experience the lives of Midwest immigrants in the late 1800s and early 1900s featuring costumed ambassadors. Explore more than 60 historical structures including 10 working farmsteads and 12 heirloom gardens by hopping on the tram. Old World Wisconsin, opened in 1976, is owned and operated by the Wisconsin Historical Society.
- Blue Bay restaurant in Mukwonago will be our lunch stop offering featuring American favorites and Greek food. You will receive \$10 toward your lunch.
- Our next stop is The Elegant Farmer — home of the best gourmet apple pie in America. The Elegant Farmer began in 1946 as a family dairy farm. They sell specialty food items including pies and crisps, baked hams, fruity apple sauces, jumbo muffins, cookies, fruit breads, blue ribbon cheeses and are best known for their “Apple Pie Baked in a Brown Bag”.
- The last stop of the day is the East Troy Railroad which dates back to 1907. The train begins at the Elegant Farmer for a 90-minute leisurely ride. Much of the track is original and the railbed was refurbished in the 1990s. Presently, the line is completely electric.

- **Cost of trip: \$95.** A \$20 non-refundable down payment is required upon registration. Final payment of \$75 due July 26, 2024.
- Cost includes: Coach bus, driver tip, ticket for Old World Wisconsin, \$10 toward your lunch, ticket for East Troy train ride.
- **7:30am departure from Menasha Senior Center. Pickup in Oshkosh at 8:00am. Approximately 5:30pm return.**
- Moderate amount of walking throughout the day.
