The ADRC is a no-cost, single point of contact for information and assistance. It can help you, or a loved one, sort out available options so you can make an



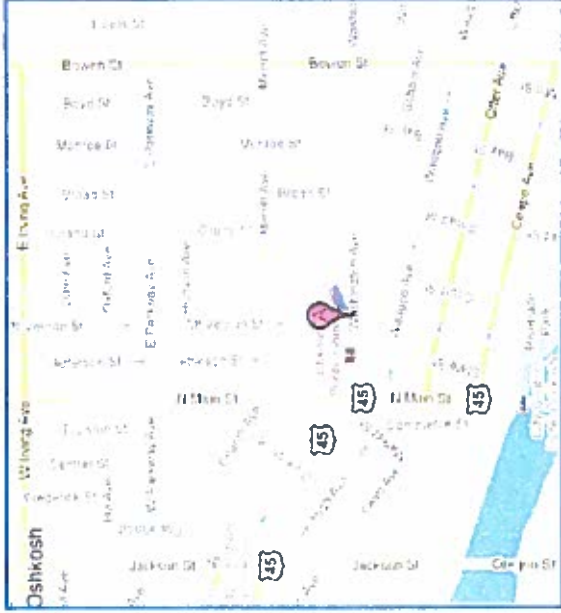
