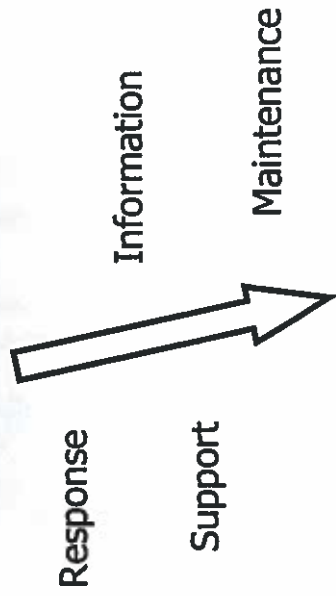

Certified Recovery Coaches

A recovery coach is someone who mentors and supports a person seeking recovery from alcohol dependency or substance abuse, helping them to take responsibility for their recovery and develop effective relapse prevention habits. All PRISM Team members are active in their own recoveries; and are CCAR-certified¹ recovery coaches.

Crisis Response

PRISM Team members are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to respond to the needs of those in crisis and those around them, providing both information and support

Assessments / Referrals

The PRISM Team has been trained to assess the needs of those in crisis from substance abuse; and make referrals to medical and treatment services.

Pre-Treatment Support

The best time to help an addict or alcoholic is immediately upon their reaching out. It is at that time of crisis that the individual has stopped denying their problem; and can talk most honestly about their using and their current situation. PRISM Team recovery coaches understand how difficult the time between the initial assessment and the start of treatment can be. Hope and encouragement is available by phone, or in group and individual settings at in a peer recovery setting.

Recovery Capital Development

Recovery capital is the collection of personal, social, and community resources that an individual accumulates to help sustain their recovery. PRISM recovery coaches work with the individual to form healthy social skills, goals, and values; establish meaningful relationships; and take ownership of their recovery process.

Working with a recovery coaching is NOT intended to take the place of attending other recovery support programs. It is, instead, a means of exploring the multiple pathways of recovery that are available, holding the individual accountable for making good choices, and applying the principles of recovery in all aspects of their daily life.

Relapse Prevention

PRISM Team members have experience to recognize and intervene in various relapse patterns. By challenging old behaviors and unhealthy thinking, recovery coaches act as guides when the going gets tough; and they act as cheerleaders in acknowledging victories over the disease of addiction.

When it seems like no one else believes in a the newly-sober addict or alcoholic, a PRISM recovery coach will provide the encouragement to keep going, because they too have been there.
