**Kwik Trip Robbery
September 17, 2018**

On Sunday, September 16, 2018 at 11:57 p.m. Menasha Police officers responded to the Kwik Trip convenience store in the 1400 block of Appleton Road. A male entered the store and demanded money. The employee working reported the suspect acted as if he had a weapon. A weapon was not displayed during the incident. The suspect left the store with cash from the register. The employee was not injured during the incident

During the investigation, a suspect description was quickly developed and officers learned the suspect fled from the scene in a vehicle. The description of the suspect and the vehicle he may be operating was relayed to neighboring police agencies. On Monday, September 17, 2018 at 1:36 a.m. Menasha officers were notified the Appleton Police Department located the suspect vehicle and were detaining the suspect for our investigation.

The male, a 48 year old Appleton resident, was taken into custody for robbery by Menasha Police. He was transported to the Winnebago County Jail. The case will be sent to the Winnebago County District Attorney's office.
