Traffic Crash Results in Overturned Milk Truck

On 3/30/2019 at 11:32 a.m., Menasha Police Department responded to a multi-vehicle traffic crash at the intersection of Third Street and Racine Street. Upon arriving on-scene officers observed a milk tanker truck overturned in the roadway. A total of four vehicles were involved in the traffic crash.

Two parties involved sustained non-life threatening injuries as a result, and were transported to area hospitals. The cause of the crash is still under investigation. As a result of the liquid spill, immediate clean-up needs were addressed by Neenah-Menasha Fire Department and Menasha Department of Public Works.

Roads in the area were closed for approximately three hours. We would like to thank the public for their patience with road closures and delays during this incident.
