**SUSPECT ARRESTED FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AFTER
SHOTS FIRED IN MENASHA**

Menasha Police are investigating a report from a 55 year old man who stated he was battered by his 31 year old son who lives with him. The man told officers that on Sunday August 25th, 2019 on Abbey Avenue in Menasha, he confronted the son over cooking cabbage late at night resulting in the son battering him and threatening to kill him with a knife. Neighbors who heard the struggle later observed the 31 year old man wielding a meat cleaver and rope shortly before he fled the scene.

Overnight, several residents including the victim of the earlier battery, heard gunshots outside the house and discovered bullet holes in a vehicle and garage. Officers were able to locate the suspect in a nearby jurisdiction and he was taken into custody without further incident. He was subsequently transported to Winnebago County Jail and booked on charges of Disorderly Conduct, Recklessly Endangering Safety, Battery, and Damage to Property. Officers recovered a firearm of the same caliber used in the shooting. No additional suspects are being sought in connection with the overnight shooting and the incident remains under investigation.
