Menasha Man Arrested After Domestic Abuse Incident

At 3:20 AM on 7/1/2020, Menasha Police responded to a 911 call in the 1200 Blk of Plank Rd for a Menasha woman that said her boyfriend had beat her up. Officers made contact with the woman and her 27 year old boyfriend who was still at the residence. The woman was immediately transported to a local trauma center with substantial facial and bodily injuries. She was eventually released from the hospital. The male subject was detained without further incident and transported to the Winnebago County Jail where he remains in custody.

Officers learned from the woman that the man had held her against her will inside of the residence for several hours. During this time he allegedly kicked, struck, and strangled her to temporary unconsciousness. The woman was eventually able to flee from the residence and call the police. During a search of the residence, numerous pieces of evidence were collected to corroborate the victim's story.

Menasha Police are referring multiple charges to the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office to include Attempted Homicide, Substantial Battery, False Imprisonment, and Strangulation.

The suspects name is not being released at this time as charges have not been formally filed.
