**Welfare Check Leads to Arrests in Menasha**

7/29/2020

A Facebook message from a 24 year old Milwaukee woman to her sister led Menasha Police to a residence on the City's East side during the morning hours of 7/29/2020. The message indicated the woman was being held against her will at the house by "drug people." When officers arrived they observed suspicious activity and made contact with several people at the scene.

After officers discussed the situation with occupants of the house, the woman was able to leave the residence and was interviewed. She stated she had been accused of stealing money by a 32 year old Oshkosh man and a 24 year old Appleton woman. They kept her in a room for several hours guarding the door to prevent her from leaving. That man and woman were transported to the Calumet County Jail on probation holds and officers requested charges of False Imprisonment, Disorderly Conduct, and Resisting Arrest with the Calumet District Attorneys Office. The victim was not injured and was transported home by relatives.

A canine officer from Winnebago Sheriff Department and a deputy from the Calumet Sheriff Department assisted.
