International Cranes Foundation and Big Cat Rescue

Learn about International Cranes Foundation featuring the 15 different species of cranes worldwide. Then, it's lions, tigers, leopards and more at the Wisconsin Big Cat Rescue which houses 20 rescued big cats from inhumane situations.

Thursday, October 10, 2024



- The International Crane Foundation works worldwide to conserve cranes and the ecosystems, watersheds and flyways on which they depend. Headquartered in Baraboo, they host approximately 100 cranes featuring the only complete collection of all 15 species worldwide. Cranes are among the most endangered families of birds in the world with ten of the fifteen species threatened with extinction. The tour will run 9:30am to 11:30am.
- We will enjoy a delicious down-home lunch at the Log Cabin in Baraboo with a selection of four entrees: 1.) roast beef 2.) turkey 3.) pecan pork 4.) salad. All meals include mashed potatoes and gravy, green beans, coffee, water and Pepsi products.
- Jeff and Jenny Kozlowski established the Wisconsin Big Cat Rescue in March 2005 with the goal to give these majestic cats a home where they can live out their lives and not be made to jump through fiery hoops or sit on a table to have their picture taken. Learn about the amazing story behind each one of these cats directly from the people who have been involved right from the inception of the rescue. You'll meet each cat and see the special bond they have with the founders. There are tigers, lions, leopards, liligers and lynx to admire and listen to each of their stories.
