## Captivating Two Rivers!

Check out Rogers Street Fishing Village, the Washington House Museum and enjoy a treat at an ice cream parlor. Then off to the London Dairy Alpaca Farm and finish up with our the last stop at Kurtz's Pub and Grill.

**Tuesday, June 11, 2024**



- Step into Rogers Street Fishing Village, full of old maritime stories and historical buildings. Step aboard the 1936 wooden fishing tug, Buddy O. See an antique Kahlenberg Marine oil engine start up. Climb up in the 1886 lighthouse for a bird's eye view of Two Rivers. Check out a French-Canadian fishing home and see how they lived. The newest exhibits feature the artifacts from the famous Vernon from 1887, and the famous Christmas Tree ship called the Rouse Simons rescued from the depths of Lake Michigan.
- The 1850 Washington House Museum features Berner's Ice Cream Parlor where the ice cream sundae was invented in 1881 when a man ordered ice cream topped with chocolate syrup. Explore five museum rooms featuring rare murals and finish off the tour with an ice cream sundae!
- Back by popular demand, we will head to the London Dairy Alpaca Farm and Kevin will talk about his love for alpacas and how he got started raising alpacas, how they use the hair from the alpaca, and what they feed alpacas. You will get a chance to feed, pet, and maybe see some alpaca babies. We will have time to browse the gift shop full of alpaca wares, unique gifts and some very tasty wines.

- **Cost of trip: \$65.** A \$20.00 non-refundable down payment is required upon registration. Final payment of \$45 due May 21, 2024.
- Cost includes: Coach bus, driver tip, water, light lunch, ice cream sundae, Rogers Fishing Village, Washington House Museum and London Dairy Alpaca Farm tours.
