Dear Ouray City Council,

The Ouray Chamber Resort Association dba Ouray Tourism Office respectfully asks for the permission to close 6th Avenue from the alley to the west of City Hall to the western-most EMS bay for the annual Oktoberfest event on Saturday, October 5, 2019.

A partial closure will begin at 8 a.m. on Saturday, October 5, primarily impacting the parking spaces in front of City hall down to the west alley. We intent to have single-lane access available throughout the event. 6th Avenue will be reopened at or before 10:30 PM on Saturday, October 5.
