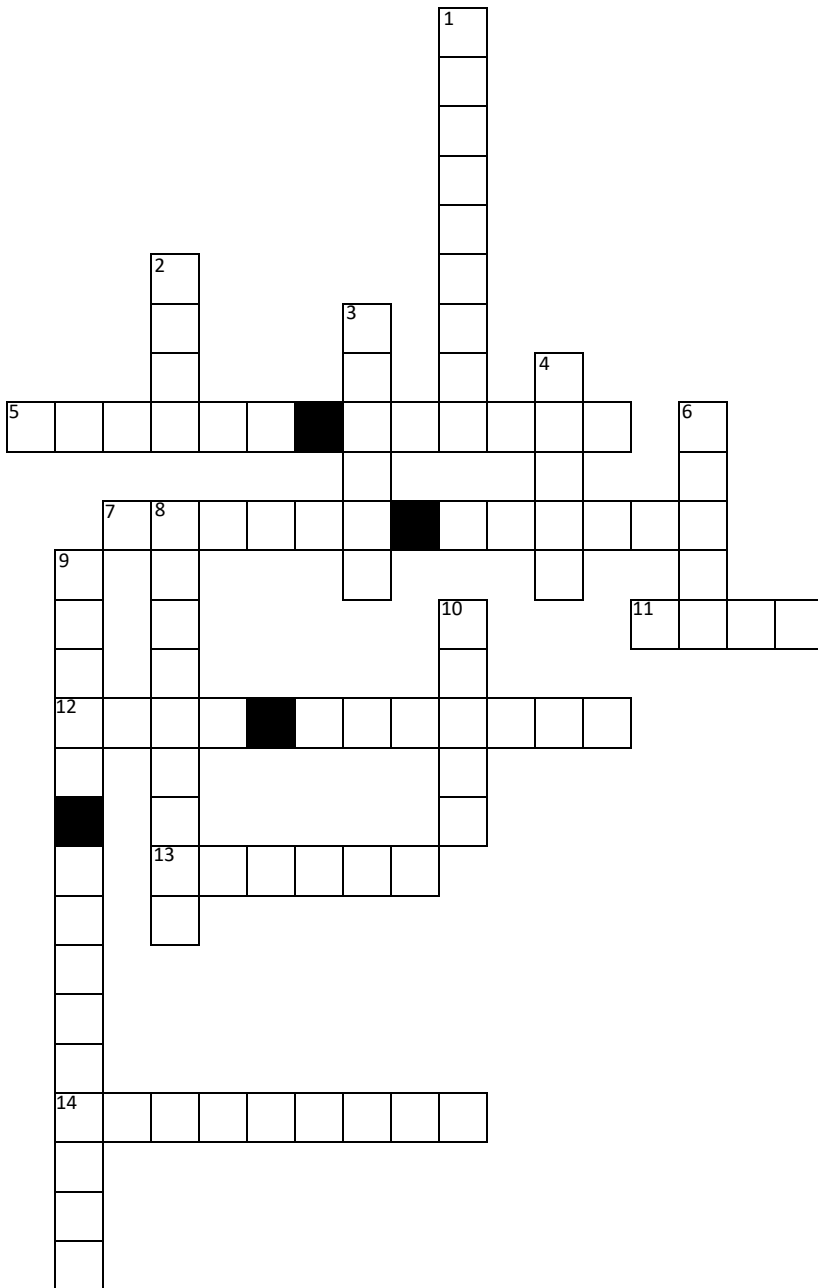


# SAGINAW CROSSWORD PUZZLE

1. A beautiful and loud display held over the Saginaw River every year in the month of July.

4. These statues are placed in front of the Saginaw County Governmental Center each year around Easter.

9. This building is dressed in lights and is revealed during the annual Holidays in the Heart of the City event.

12. This community merged with Saginaw in 1889 to become the City of Saginaw.
13. These brothers owned one of the nation's second largest hardware store of its time on North Washington Avenue.
14. The regionally-famous Pere \_\_\_\_\_ Railway ran through Saginaw and connected it to other destinations such as Buffalo, NY; Toledo, OH; and Chicago, IL.
