- Businesses and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply for funds
- Businesses must possess and active City of Sedro-Woolley business license, if required by law
- Applications must be approved prior to the project start date

- Maximum funding limit is \$5,000 per nonprofit, or \$10,000 per business
- National franchises are not eligible
- Improvements must be made to a public-facing area.
- Projects will be vetted for completeness by City staff, may go to the Arts Commission for recommendation to the City Council, and will be subject to a public advisory vote. The City Council will make the final decision on whether to fund a project.
- Once funded, grants will be reimbursement grants. One exception is for projects greater than \$20,000 in total. Those projects can have their city-eligible funds reimbursed when they are more than 50% complete.

Double Barrel BBQ Community Development Grant Project. A four-point plan to enhance the look of the business, engage the local community and increase taxable revenue.

- 1. Parking lot lighting enhancement: Extending the restaurant parking lot lighting to effectively cover the entire parking area, creating not only a more inviting atmosphere but also a safer environment. Better lighting allows us to use the entire adjacent parking lot, thereby packing in more customers and bringing in more sales. Our safe, well-lit lot also accommodates a variety of oversized vehicles on a regular basis, from energy companies' bucket trucks to locals' racecars to travelers' RVs, snowmobiles and dirt bikes. A safe and roomy parking lot accommodates more customers and increases revenue.
- 2. Signs and flag lighting enhancement: Increasing the lighting on the flags and signs on the building to enhance our marketing strategy while also capturing potential customers' attention and enticing them to the restaurant. The flags being well-lit imparts a quiet patriotic theme that appeals to our local community and encourages them to patronize our business. Customers are drawn to our hometown values and tend to spend their hard-earned money in like-minded businesses. This in turn strengthens community relations and encourages locals to support our business. More support leads to more sales, which leads to more tax revenue.
- 3. Landscaping and window boxes: Generally beautifying the property will make it more inviting and appealing, which attracts more customers. Constructing and filling the window boxes creates an opportunity to purchase materials from local suppliers, thereby increasing their sales revenues in the process. Strengthening ties between local businesses is good for everyone.
- 4. Parking lot re-striping, markers and bike rack: This will accomplish three goals: improving the overall aesthetic of the business; easing customers' ingress and egress, which allows for increased guest turnover and more sales; and relieving automobile traffic and congestion by making it easy and appealing for local customers to bike instead of drive to the restaurant.

- 1. Enhanced parking lot lighting will make it easier and safer for customers to visit our business and accommodates vehicles too large for many parking areas. All of this works to increase taxable revenue.
- 2. Sign and flag lighting improvements will entice potential guests with a stronger marketing message and impression of our business. More guests equals more taxable revenue.
- 3. Landscaping, window boxes and planters will beautify the property and capture the attention of those passing by. Plants and flowers create pleasing visual stimulation, decrease stress levels and increase happiness. Happy customers spend more money!
- 4. Parking lot re-striping, markers and a bike rack will facilitate more safety and efficiency in guests' travels. Additionally, the overall improved aesthetic will attract new customers, generate return visits and further cement customer loyalty.
