- Improvements must be made to a public-facing area.
- Projects will be vetted for completeness by City staff, may go to the Arts Commission for recommendation to the City Council, and will be subject to a public advisory vote. The City Council will make the final decision on whether to fund a project.
- Once funded, grants will be reimbursement grants. One exception is for projects greater than \$20,000 in total. Those projects can have their city-eligible funds reimbursed when they are more than 50% complete.

Proposal - provide an explanation of the project including who/what/where/when/why, attach at least three photos of the area/areas needing improvement (500 words or less):

In 2019, just prior to the COVID lockdowns, I added the retail gallery, Trinky Busiu, to my metal working studio on the prominent corner of Woodworth St. and Eastern Ave. I plan to extend my gallery next year by adding a landscaped courtyard in which to sell outdoor sculptural elements. The space enclosed will be approximately 30' x 30' and consist of an 8' high fence (composed of vertical ½" round bars approximately 3" apart) and structural steel crossbars. The ground will be covered with pavers for drainage and a safe walking surface. The public will access the area through securable exterior gates or through a new door in the existing gallery wall.

Additional features will include: a large bamboo mural on the north building wall; 3 metal and colorful glass screens for the northwest corner of the lot to further enhance the look of the property and attract attention to the new outdoor gallery.

The space is currently very unattractive (see photos) but the proposed landscaped courtyard will leave enough room for me to assemble my larger public artwork while hiding it behind the courtyard.

I plan to do all the work myself and purchase/rent all materials locally, when possible, which will also increase tax revenue for the City.


