City Administrator Report

Police Chief Lin Tucker presented the City Administrator's report to the Mayor and Councilmembers. There is a new covered shelter going up over the barbeque pits down at Riverfront Park. Also, the rise in fuel costs is a concern of every department and the city is monitoring and continue to work out plans to deal with rising costs.

Staff Reports

Mark Freiberger, Public Works Director, spoke of additional plans for the construction project down at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. Also, the budget did not have allowances to finish out the second floor of the new Public Works building project and Carletti Architects is working on plans for that to get finished out.

Councilmember and Mayor's Report

Councilmembers spoke of the Farmer's Market has opened for the season. American Legion will be placing flags at the cemetery tomorrow for observance of Memorial Day. There is also

talk about the possibility of having vendors included with the Little League tournament this summer. The Mayor provided information about the ribbon-cutting ceremony for the YMCA on June 22, 2022 at 1:00 P.M. at 802 Ball St. She mentioned that the COVID-19 reports show a 64% increase in cases and 2 related deaths in the past seven days. The mayor also made a statement regarding the school shooting that took place and asked that the community keep the people of Uvalde, TX in their thoughts over the coming days.
