2. 2023-2024 Budget Follow-Up. Finance Director Kelly Kohnken presented information on the budget and answered questions that came up during the last City Council Meeting.
3. Community Development Grant Program – Councilmember Burns presented information to help recruit younger folks to volunteer to serve the community and share a sense of ownership among citizens of the city.
