**Zero Depth Pool:** This fun pool area includes a gradual beach-like entry into the water that is 3'-6" at its deepest. Interactive water toys and a frog slide are included for guests under 48". This pool area requires a minimum of one lifeguard and up to three lifeguards depending on group size and age.

**Main Pool:** This pool is has six lanes, is 25 yards long, and includes two one-meter diving boards. Pool depth varies from 3'-6" to 10'-0". This pool requires a minimum of one lifeguard but usually 2 or more life guards depending on group size and age.

**Slides and Slide Pool:** This four story water slide requires riders to be 48" or taller. It also features one enclosed and one open water slide. The pool depth is 3'-6" and requires 2 lifeguards at all times.

**Concession Stand:** This area provides a wide variety of items to your guests. Items include but are not limited to ice cream novelties, a variety of candy bars, pretzels, and nachos. This is often staffed by the Pool Manager or Head Lifeguard as needed.

#### **Facility Rules:**

1. No more than 343 people will be allowed in attendance.
2. Every swimmer will be required to have a shower prior to entering the water.
3. No suits with metal allowed on any of the slides. These small rivets or buttons will damage the slide.
4. No more than one person on a slide or diving board at a time.
5. No food or drink around the water.
6. Lap swimmers may use kick-boards, hand paddles, pull buoys, masks, fins, and snorkels only for swimming in assigned lanes.
7. Wrist bands must be worn on the right hand at all times when in pool area.
8. No running, pushing, or horseplay is allowed.
9. No glass bottles are allowed on pool deck.
10. No alcoholic beverages are allowed whatsoever and no one will be allowed to stay if they are under the influence of alcohol.
11. No flotation devices other than Coast Guard approved life-jackets will be allowed in the water at anytime. This includes water wings, swimming eggs or any suit with built in flotation.
12. A person is not to be thrown or pushed into or under the water.
13. Children in diapers will not be allowed in the water. Children must be in Little Swimmers or have rubber pants.
14. Anyone who is guilty of continually violating rules should have their behavior corrected appropriately. Only the Aquatic Manager can expel someone from a venue.
