To be an election worker, you must:

- Be registered to vote in Colfax County
- Be able to read and write
- Be able to carry out a poll worker's duties with acceptable skill and dispatch
- Attend Election School
- Take an oath of office
- Not be a candidate, law officer, or close relative (spouse, parent, child, sibling, or in-law) of a candidate
