PERMISSION SLIP Student Election Judge

MN Statutes 204B.19 subd 6... “a student enrolled in a high school in MN who has attained the age of 16 is eligible to be appointed without party affiliation as a trainee election judge...” The student may be excused from school during the hours he/she is serving at the polls if the student submits a written permission slip signed by the student’s parent or guardian.

In order to work as election judges, students must complete (no exceptions) a 2 hour course of “Basic Election Judge Training”. The City of Columbia Heights offers on-line training for students who wish to serve as Student Election Judges. You will be provided with an on-line election judge training letter and code to complete this training.

Any student interested in serving as an election judge on **Tuesday, February 13, 2024** and/or **March 5, 2024** should complete this permission slip and return it to the Clerk as soon as possible.
