
Tactical 4Sight R/C

436.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the use of and maintenance of the Tactical 4Sight R/C.

The Columbia Heights Police Department may deploy the 4Sight when an officer believes doing so will increase the safety of the public and/ or officer. The 4Sight should only be deployed into a location where an officer has the constitutional right to enter that location.

436.2 HANDLING AND STORAGE

The 4Sight as well as the extra 3-cell lithium-ion batteries should remain inside the pelican case when not in use.

The 4Sight R/C described in this policy may be carried in the patrol squad car and used by an officer who has completed the roll call training.

Some examples of situations where the deployment of the 4Sight R/C would provide increased safety to the public and/or officer may include:

- (a) To communicate with a suspect
- (b) To locate a suspect
- (c) To search a structure

436.3 OPERATOR RESPONSIBILITIES

All routine maintenance, charging or cleaning shall remain the responsibility of the member using the 4Sight and shall be in accordance with manufacturer recommendation or training.

Any damage, inoperative, outdated batteries, and related accessories, along with documentation explaining any cause of damage, shall be reported to the on duty sergeant or senior officer. Any damages caused to the device shall also be recorded in a police report.

436.4 COVER OFFICER

Because the 4Sight R/C utilizes a body camera and cell phone to see the area being searched, The operator will most likely be concentrating on the device. A cover officer is needed as the operator may be occupied with the operation of the 4Sight R/C.
