

# COLUMBIA HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL



The City of Columbia Heights is governed by a fivemember council, consisting of a mayor and four council members elected at large on a nonpartisan basis. The mayor serves a two-year term, with councilmembers serving staggered, four-year terms. City Council elections are held in even-numbered years. #### CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

The City Council meets at City Hall (3989 Central Ave NE) on the second and fourth Monday of every month at 6 pm. Agendas are posted online before all City meetings. The public is welcome to attend City Council meetings in person, or they can be viewed on Government Access Cable Channel 16 or on our website at columbiaheightsmn.gov/streaming.

#### **REFUSE SUPPORT**

# WINTER PARKING

From Nov 15 to March 15, it is unlawful to park any vehicle on any street within the City between the hours of 2 and 6 am unless a permit has been issued for that vehicle. Additionally, no street parking is allowed after two inches or more of snow accumulation until streets have been cleared.
