RESIDENT UPDATES

2023 HUD INSPECTION BE "REAC" READY

To prepare your home for the REAC inspection and repairs.

1. If you are not at home your pet must be caged.
2. All the floors must be clean and free from any items that may block clear walking access.
3. No furniture should block windows, doors, or stairwells.
4. Bathrooms and kitchen areas must be clean. Toilets cleaned, showers and sinks wiped down, countertop areas cleaned and the stovetop and oven must clean.
5. No cable wires across the floor or across door openings in your home.
6. All smoke & CO2 detectors must be in place. Notify the office immediately if detectors are beeping and the batteries need to be replaced.
