



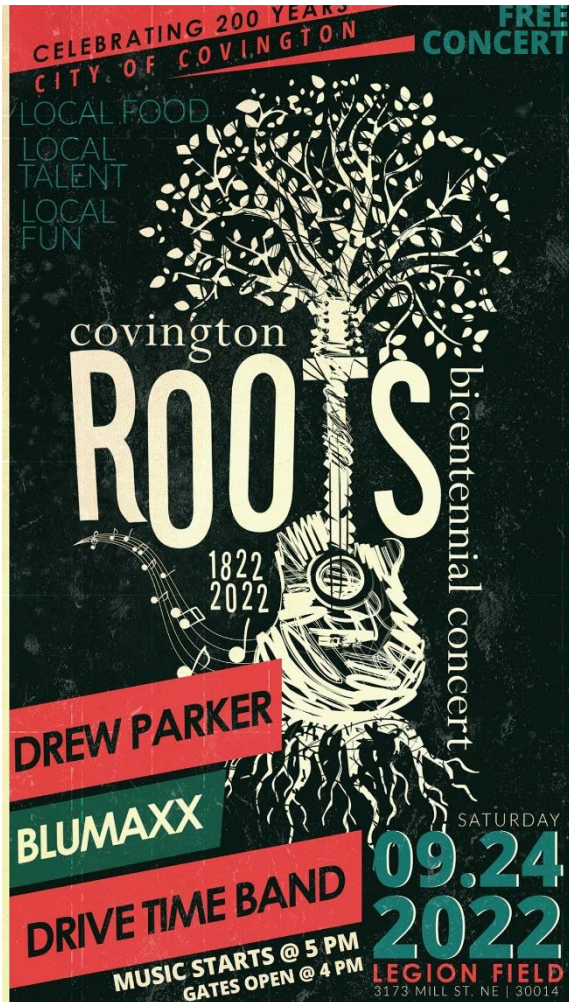

1. Residents are reminded of your responsibility to keep your home and neighborhood safe.

The grounds on CHA communities are an important asset and are maintained for the enjoyment of residents and their guests.

In administering these policies, the Resident's grounds (yard) is considered to extend FIFTEEN (15) feet from the exterior walls and adjoining units will be jointly responsible.

11.1. e Residents will be charged and cited for a lease violation if Facilities Maintenance has to pick up litter, trash, toys, furniture, bicycles, in a resident's front or back yard area.
