

**ORDINANCE 2022-8**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF  
CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, EXTENDING THE DUE  
DATE FOR THE CITY TAX BILLS FOR REAL ESTATE AND  
TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY  
LIMITS OF CRESCENT SPRINGS TO NOVEMBER 30, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the tax bills that are due for the current fiscal year were mailed on September 28, 2022, to all residents and property owners within the city limits of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that a large number of bills were not received by citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the normal deadline to pay the property taxes without penalty or interest expired on October 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that because of the unusually large number of tax bills remaining outstanding that an issue has arisen with regard to the delivery of said bills; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Crescent Springs, that extending the deadline to pay the property taxes without penalty or interest is necessary because of the unusual developments that have arisen; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the due date of the bills an emergency has arisen pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7),

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

The City hereby declares an emergency exists pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7). The deadline to pay ad valorem city real estate taxes and tangible property tax on personal property for residents and property owners of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, is hereby extended for this year only until November 30, 2022. No penalty or interest shall be imposed by the City pursuant to previous Ordinances until December 1, 2022.
