### **Z21 Working Group**

### **Joint Finance Meeting between Crescent Springs & Vila Hills:**

- Crescent Springs has invited Villa Hills to join our finance meeting on Tuesday, February 21<sup>st</sup> at 4:30pm here at the City Building.
- The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the CVFA budget for FY2023-2024 per the inter-local agreement.
- This will also give us the opportunity to review the progress and financial status of the firehouse building project.
- Villa Hills Councilman Jim Cahill will be sending out a preliminary budget prior to the meeting.

### **AltaFiber Project:**

- We have fielded several calls from concerned residents regarding the work that is being completed by Altafiber in the Crescent Springs Community.
- To clarify, this is a Kenton County Fiscal Court project not a city project.

- All the work is in the right-a-way (There is a right-a-way of 25+ feet from center of the road to utility boxes, fire hydrants and or telephone poles etc).
- Utilities have permission to be there from the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
- Any issues, the residents need to call and get their complaint in the pipeline for investigation and possible resolution at **513-566-8130** (*It's the customer service line for Altafiber*).

**Woodhill Court Sidewalk Idea:**

- At the last Caucus Meeting the idea of constructing a sidewalk on a portion of Woodhill Court.
- Starts right by the Hills at Housing at Crescent Springs and travels towards Western Reserve Road.
- The Public Works Director and I met with Greg Sketch our City Engineer at the site last week to discuss the idea further.
- The idea would be to add/design a sidewalk to increase safety, particularly for children going to school along with walkers/runners/bicyclist that utilize this stretch.
- Research related to grant funding for this type sidewalk project are the following:
  - a. **Safe Routes to Schools grant from Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC).**
