The emergency meeting of the Crescent Springs City Council was called to order by Mayor Mike Daugherty at 12:00pm.

Roll call showed the following council members present – Carol McGowan, Patrick Hackett, Deborah Noe and Chad Longbons. Jeannine Bell Smith and Christie Arlinghaus were not in attendance. Also present were City Clerk April Robinson, City Administrator Mike Daly and City Attorney Mike Baker.

Mayor Mike Daugherty explained that the meeting was to consider an emergency ordinance in regards to tax bills not being received by a large number of residents.

Emergency Ordinance 2022-8

Attorney Mike Baker conducted the Reading of **Emergency Ordinance 2022-8** EXTENDING THE DUE DATE FOR THE CITY TAX BILLS FOR REAL ESTATE AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF CRESCENT SPRINGS TO NOVEMBER 30, 2022

Mayor Daugherty stated that because of the number of phone calls and outstanding tax bills the city has passing this ordinance would be in the best interest of our residents.

Patrick Hackett asked if the tax bills would be taken to the Dixie Post office as soon as the ordinance was passed and bills prepared in order to expedite. April Robinson stated they would.

Deborah Noe asked if a message would be placed on the digital signs so people would know that the date has been extended. Mayor Daugherty stated that you are limited in the message that you can display on the digital signs and would prefer we place a message on the website and Facebook explaining the reason for the extension.
