

## ORDINANCE 2023-5

### **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY REGARDING DAMAGE FROM STORMS ON EUBANKS ROAD, AND AUTHORIZATION TO EFFECTUATE REPAIRS RESULTING FROM SAID DAMAGE, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, as a result of recent storms and rainfall, a roadway collapse has occurred on Eubanks Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the roadway collapse currently creates a safety hazard for said collapse blocks access to a portion of Eubanks Road, impairing the ability of residents, school busses, and emergency vehicle from traveling on Eubanks Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City hereby declares an emergency to exist, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) or more of City Council, pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY**, as follows:

#### Section I

An emergency, pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7), is hereby declared to allow the City to address necessary repairs resulting from a roadway collapse on Eubanks Road, within the City limits.

#### Section II

The City is authorized to make necessary repairs in an amount up to \$100,000.00 to make repairs to Eubanks Road, as a result of the roadway collapse that has damaged and is still restricting travel on said road, including any necessary expenditures to Geotechnology, Inc., an engineering firm, for its work.

#### Section III

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any document necessary to effectuate the repairs necessary so that the repairs to Eubanks Road can be made.

#### Section IV

This Ordinance shall become effective upon the first reading and its adoption upon the vote

of two-thirds (2/3) or more of City Council, as a result of the emergency situation on Eubanks Road.
