RE: Crooks Recreational Facilities Committee

The purpose of this memo is to update everyone on recent activities in the Crooks Community. The various entities are proceeding with their process of reviewing and recommending upcoming projects, as follows:

1. Tri-Valley School District: As we know from attending School Board Meetings, their initial project to build an Elementary School adjacent to the Community Center has reportedly expanded to include improvements to other facilities in the district. This project growth will apparently now require a reported \$16m bond issue in the upcoming months. Due to uncertainty in the School District, the Recreational Facilities Committee (RFC) reached consensus at their last meeting for Burbach Aquatics, Inc. (BAI) to focus on the available City property at the Community Center.

BAI will be providing a revised Conceptual Site/Facilities Floor Plan (CSFFP) showing the Recreation Center and a proposed municipal pool footprint at that location. Both of these elements will be placed on City property with a notation that school property may someday become available. Based on information known at this time, there is no reason to attend the upcoming School Board meeting. Mr. Nelson has agreed to contact the School Superintendent

and have the RFC appearance removed from their Agenda;

2. CHRC Board: Recently, the CHRC Board voted to consider placement of the Recreation Center and municipal swimming pool at one of two locations. The first location was the above mentioned Community Center site, while the second is located at their present development on Fourth Street. BAI will be preparing a new CSFFP for this site showing the Recreation Center and municipal swimming pool;

3. Mayor: The Mayor has asked that we work towards completing the RFC's study. BAI will be scheduling a meeting in February for the RFC, in which we will review the two above described CSFFP's. If the RFC reaches consensus on a preferred CSFFP we will then set up a meeting to rehearse a presentation to the Mayor and City Council. BAI will reach out to the RFC once we have the two CSFFP's completed.
