

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SUM OF \$1,376.68 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTAL FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS: TO THE FINANCE OFFICE the sum of \$1,311.81; TO THE STREET AND ALLEY AND SNOW REMOVAL FUND the sum of \$64.87; FOR THE ROUTINE OPERATION OF THE TOWN OF CROOKS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the incorporation of the Town of Crooks, there has been no annual appropriation ordinance since there were no funds to appropriate, and whereas funds have now come into the general fund of the town, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the operation of the town and the discharge of its lawful duties and the performance of its indispensable functions to provide funds for the Finance Office and the Street and Alley and Snow Removal Fund of the Town of Crooks, South Dakota,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, TOWN OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Town of Crooks, South Dakota, the sum of \$1,376.68 to the following departmental funds, in the following amounts, for the purpose of paying any lawful claim incurred by said departments for the remainder of the calendar year, 1979:

Whereas this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and support of the municipal government of the Town of Crooks, and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon the passage and publication hereof.
