

ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING VEHICLE TRAFFIC AND PARKING DURING PERIODS OF SNOW AND PROVIDING PROCEDURES, COSTS AND PENALTIES WITH REGARD THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave unattended any motor vehicle on any public street or road in the Town of Crooks, South Dakota, immediately after two (2) inches of snow has accumulated thereon and until such snow has been cleared.


Section 2. Any vehicle parked or left unattended in violation of Section 1. above may be removed, without notice, at the direction of the Town Overseer of Highways or the Board of Trustees of the Town, and towed or removed to a location designated by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3. The owner of any vehicle so removed or towed shall pay all charges and costs of towing, removal and storage of the vehicle and the owner shall assume the risk of any damage done to the vehicle during removal, towing or storage.

Section 4. In addition, the owner of any such vehicle shall be subject to a fine of \$25.00 plus Court costs for a violation of this ordinance.
