

ORDINANCE NO.132

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SUM OF \$41,000 FROM SECOND PENNY SALES TAX FUNDS TO THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTS IN THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTAL FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS: CAPITOL IMPROVEMENTS (WARNING SIRENS) \$41,000 FOR THE ROUTINE OPERATION OF THE CITY OF CROOKS FOR THE YEAR 2003; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the Second Penny Sales Tax of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, in September of 2003, it has been found necessary for the operation of the City of Crooks, South Dakota and the discharge of its lawful duties and the performance of its indispensable functions to provide additional funds for the CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS of the City of Crooks, South Dakota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from Second Penny Sales Tax Fund of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, the sum of \$41,000 to the following department, in the following amount, for the purpose of paying any lawful claim incurred by said department of the remainder of the calendar year, 2003.


CAPITOL IMPROVEMENTS \$41,000

Section 2. Whereas this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and support of the municipal government of the City of Crooks, and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon the passage and publication hereof.
