

ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SUM OF \$29,070.65 FROM 2009 GENERAL FUNDS 2009 DEPARTMENT CARRYOVER, \$1500 FROM PARK DONATIONS AND \$20,080 GENERAL FUNDS TO THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTAL FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS, \$9000 COMMUNITY CENTER, \$2000 SNOW REMOVAL, \$18,070.65 PARK DEVELOPMENT, \$1500 PARK DEVELOPMENT(DONATION) AND \$20,080 STREETS FOR THE ROUTINE OPERATION OF THE CITY OF CROOKS FOR THE YEAR 2010; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, in October of 2009, it has been found necessary for the operation of the City of Crooks, South Dakota and the discharge of its lawful duties and the performance of its indispensable functions to provide additional funds for the COMMUNITY CENTER, SNOW REMOVAL, PARK DEVELOPMENT & STREET funds of the City of Crooks, South Dakota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA:


Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from General Funds of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, the sum of \$50,650.65 to the following departmental funds, in the following amounts, for the purpose of paying any lawful claim incurred by said departments for the remainder of the calendar year, 2010.


COMMUNITY CENTER	\$ 9,000.00
SNOW REMOVAL	\$ 2,000.00
PARKS DEVELOPMENT	\$ 18,070.65
STREETS	\$ 20,080.00
PARK DEVELOPMENT	\$ 1500.00

Section 2. Whereas this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and support of the municipal government of the City of Crooks, and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon the passage and publication hereof.
