Ordinance No. 235

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 113 (An ordinance establishing requirements for the maintenance of trees within the city of Crooks public right of ways), Section 1.04 (Planting of trees).

Be it ordained by the Crooks city council that Ordinance No. 113, section 1.04 (planting of trees) is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1.04 Planting of trees, the following passage be inserted:

1. The City of Crooks shall establish rules and regulations for the planting of trees in the public parking strip, including, but not limited to:

- (A) Only approved species and varieties of trees may be planted in the parking strip;
- (B) No tree shall be planted where the clear space between the curb and the sidewalk is less than five feet;
- (C) No tree shall be planted closer than ten feet from the curb;
- (D) Trees shall not be planted under power lines unless approved by the City;
- (E) Trees shall be planted at least 40 feet apart except where otherwise permitted by the City;
- (F) Trees shall be placed at least ten feet from a fire hydrant;
- (G) Trees shall be placed at least ten feet from a driveway;
- (H) Trees shall be placed at least 20 feet from a streetlight;
- (I) Trees on a corner lot shall be planted at least 40 feet back from the corner; and
- (J) Trees shall be placed at least 20 feet back from stop/yield sign or traffic signal.
- (K) All deciduous trees shall have a 1 ¾ caliper and all coniferous trees shall have a 5' minimum size

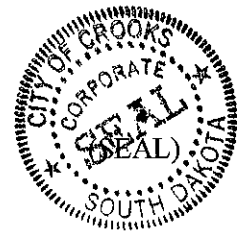
And the following passage be struck.
