

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SUM OF \$4,911.23 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTAL FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS: TO THE PARK FUND THE SUM OF \$300.00; TO THE HIGHWAYS & STREETS FUND THE SUM OF \$3,811.23; AND TO THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT FUND THE SUM OF \$800.00: FOR THE ROUTINE OPERATION OF THE CITY OF CROOKS FOR THE YEAR, 1982; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Crooks, South Dakota in October of 1981, it has been found necessary for the operation of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, and the discharge of its lawful duties and the performance of its indispensable functions to provide additional funds for the Park Fund, the Highways & Streets Fund, and the Volunteer Fire Department Fund of the City of Crooks, South Dakota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from previously unappropriated funds in the General Fund of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, the sum of \$4,911.23 to the following departmental funds, in the following amounts, for the purpose of paying any lawful claim incurred by said departments for the remainder of the calendar year, 1982.

a. Park Fund	\$300.00
b. Highways & Streets Fund	\$3,811.23
c. Volunteer Fire Dept. Fund	\$800.00.


Section 2. Whereas this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and support of the municipal government of the City of Crooks, and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon the passage and publication hereof.
