

ORDINANCE NO. 73

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF THE CITY, PERTAINING TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF CROOKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA:

That Ordinance No. 2 of the City adopted December 7, 1978, pertaining to the Planning and Zoning Commission for the City of Crooks, is hereby amended as follows:

A. That Section 3. thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Membership of the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Crooks shall consist of at least three (3) and no more than seven (7) members, all of whom shall be appointed by the governing board of the municipality. One of the members of the Commission shall be the Mayor or one of the Aldermen, as appointed by the governing board of the municipality."

B. That Section 4. thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. Terms of Office and Vacancy. The term of each Planning Commission member shall be for three (3) years, except that when the Commission is first appointed, following enactment of this ordinance, one or more of the members shall be appointed for one (1) year, one or more of the members shall be appointed for two (2) years, and one or more of the members shall be appointed for three (3) years. Thereafter, appointment of each member shall be for a term of three (3) years so that there will be an overlapping of tenures. Any vacancy on the Commission shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment of the governing board of the municipality."

C. That Section 5. thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Removal of Member. All Planning Commission members serve at the will of the governing board of the municipality, and as such, may be removed or replaced at any time by the governing board of the municipality without notice and without cause or reason."

D. That Section 6. thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Compensation. All Planning Commission members shall serve with or without compensation, as the governing board of the municipality shall, from time to time decide. Compensation, if any, shall be in the amount(s) from time to time set by the governing board of the municipality."

E. That Section 7. thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. Officers. The Commission shall elect a recording secretary and a chairman from among its members each for a term of one year with eligibility for re-election, and may elect such other officers as it may choose in a manner prescribed by the rules of the Commission. The governing board of the municipality may, at any time, pre-empt the Commission and make its own appointment of chairman, recording secretary and other officers, if any."

F. That Section 8. thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. Meetings-Rules-Public Record. The Commission shall hold meetings as often and at such times as it shall deem appropriate and at the times directed by the governing board of the municipality, and shall adopt rules for transaction of its business and keep a record of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations which shall be a public record."


