

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SUM OF \$17,300 FROM GENERAL FUNDS TO THE FOLLOWING DEPARTMENTAL FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS: \$10,000.00 PAVED STREETS/ \$800.00 STREET LIGHTING/ \$2500.00 SANITATION/\$4000 SNOW REMOVAL FOR THE ROUTINE OPERATION OF THE CITY OF CROOKS FOR THE YEAR 2001; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, in September of 2000, it has been found necessary for the operation of the City of Crooks, South Dakota and the discharge of its lawful duties and the performance of its indispensable functions to provide additional funds for the PAVED STREETS, STREET LIGHTING, SANITATION and SNOW REMOVAL funds of the City of Crooks, South Dakota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROOKS, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from General Funds of the City of Crooks, South Dakota, the sum of \$17,300.00 to the following departmental funds, in the following amounts, for the purpose of paying any lawful claim incurred by said departments for the remainder of the calendar year, 2001.

PAVED STREETS	\$ 10000.00
STREET LIGHTING	\$ 800.00
SANITATION	\$ 2500.00
SNOW REMOVAL	\$ 4000.00

Section 2. Whereas this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and support of the municipal government of the City of Crooks, and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon the passage and publication hereof.


