Katie Vanderhulst from Abonmarche was unable to attend this meeting. Manager Tapper shared some information from Katies presentation, and was provided with a list of questions regarding the Splash Pad- Red Woolfe Park Project.

VII. <u>Unfinished Business – Splash Pad Designs/ Red Woolfe Park Project</u>

The proposed site plan was reviewed and discussed. It was agreed that the added expenditure of the walking path was not necessary at this time.

PR Committee members considered the restrooms/concessions building at Red Woolfe Park, and discussed if it was more feasible to reconstruct or rebuild-final determination will be made after estimates for both are reviewed.

There was discussion about the fence line along the property alongside the parking lot. Members agreed some small trees/shrubs should be removed, pending property line determination. Native habitat buffers and visually appealing landscaping are preferred in this area.

Committee members were all in favor of the proposed tree removal plan.

There was lengthy discussion about the proposed natural habitat area on the site plan. PRC Members agreed that if the area is not conditionally necessary for our design and grant opportunities, the preferred placement of these native plants would be with the proposed evergreen buffer to give more privacy to neighboring properties.

Committee members were asked to provide feedback and input on the Community Engagement Survey.





To Whom It May Concern:

The Village of Decatur is pursuing a grant opportunity through the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for improvements at Red Woolfe Park located at 45280 Pine Street, Decatur, MI 49045. The Michigan Spark Grant Program aims to help communities improve and redevelop existing public recreation facilities, and we see no better fit than the proposed project.

We have been working with landscape architects, engineers, and grant writers to prepare an application to this program for funding. The proposed improvements include the following:

- New evergreen buffer at both south and west edge of the property along fence line;
- New native habitat proposed to be located at west side of property;
- New ADA accessible splash pad proposed to be located at west side of property;
- New ADA accessible seating areas proposed to be located at several locations at west side of property;
- New trash and recycle bins proposed to be located at west side of property;
- New "foot shower" and drinking fountain proposed to be located at west side of property;
- New ADA accessible route connecting parking lot area to beach and kayak launch, splash pad and concession stand / restroom area;
- New kayak rack and kayak launch proposed to be located at southwest corner of property;
- Expanding existing beach area further northwest of property.

Please refer to the attached planset for more details regarding the proposed improvements.

It is our goal as a Village to solicit feedback from constituents who utilize this space, and your organization has been identified as a possible user given your proximity to the park.



We value your contribution to the community and wish to better service your mission by providing thoughtful upgrades to Red Woolfe Park.

SUBJECT: Review of park rules/regulations and updating signage

Action Requested:

It is requested that the Parks and Recreation Committee review and update the current signage at it pertains to park rules and information.

Background:

With many future plans for the use of our parks, a clear, concise and uniform set of rules should be posted at each location. At this time, The Southside Skate Park, Red Woolfe Park, and Raider Romp all have a variety of signage that shares some similarities, but many of these signs are worn and in need of replacement.

Please review current signage rules and regulations. Consider updating park rules so one sign could be used at all locations. Condensing all information (hours, rules/regulations, contact information) would allow for fewer signs to be posted.

Updating and posting such rules would result in less litter (trash, cigarettes, containers, etc.) in our parks, and make using them more desirable for future events.

General Park Rules

PARK HOURS: 5:00 A.M. - 11:00 P.M.

PETS ON LEASH



Municipal Code requires dogs to be restrained on a lease no longer than 8' at all times except in designated areas. Clean up pet waste.

ALCOHOL BY PERMIT ONLY



Consuming alcohol on park property is prohibited except in designated areas with approved liquor permit.

SMOKING



It is unlawful to smoke tobacco, vape tobacco, smoke marijuana, vape marijuana in any city park.

NO UNAUTHORIZED MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON TURF



Vehicles are to be driven on designated park roads and parking areas only.

SPECIAL EVENTS BY PERMIT ONLY



A special event permit is required for activities that impact the general use of a park.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL



Trash receptacles are for park use and not for residential or commercial waste.

INFLATABLES/ CANOPIES/TENTS



Use of inflatable play structures and shade canopies/tents on park property is prohibited without prior approval.

FACILITY RENTALS



Reservations made for a park facility have priority. If facility is not reserved, it is first come, first serve. Use facilities at your own risk. All other park rules apply. Refer to City of Walla Walla Municipal Code.
