

ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ADDITION OF FLUORIDE TO WATER SUPPLIED TO THE PUBLIC BY THE VILLAGE OF DECATUR, MICHIGAN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE STATE OF MICHIGAN IN PUBLIC ACT. NO. 346 OF 1968.

THE VILLAGE OF DECATUR, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1 – That water supplied to the public by the Village of Decatur, or water supplied to the public by any governmental agency under the direction and control of the Village of Decatur, shall not be treated by the addition of fluoride, the addition of fluoride being hereby rejected by said Village.

SECTION 2 - This ordinance shall become effective the 4th day of June, 1973.
