Please put all yard waste in proper bags and place them on curb for pick up. Be sure to call us if you have yard bags that need to be picked up.

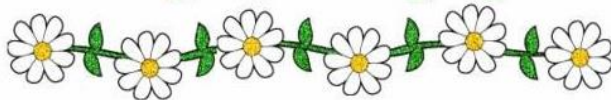
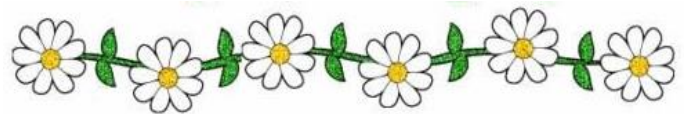
