CHIEF JUDGE ANNOUNCES
CLOSING OF JUDICIAL OFFICE
FACILITY ON JANUARY 30 & 31,
2019

With a forecast of severe and dangerous weather conditions predicted for the area, Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin has announced that the 18th Judicial Circuit and all divisions thereof, including traffic courts, will be closed on Wednesday, January 30th and Thursday, January 31st; Bond Court will be conducted at 8:00 am on both January 30th and 31st in Courtroom 1000 located at the DuPage County Sheriff's Office. There will be no Bond Court at 4:00 pm on those dates.

"We have been closely monitoring the hazardous and dangerous weather conditions forecast for both Wednesday and Thursday and have determined that closing the courthouse both days is necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of our employees and the public," said Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin.

The Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court will be closed, and the time for filing motions, answers or any other pleading, process or paper which would expire on January 30 or 31, 2019 is extended to February 1, 2019.

All cases set for January 30 and 31, 2019 will be continued to a date determined by the court and notices of the future court dates will be generated by the Circuit Clerk. All matters are returnable and the time for filing motions and pleadings is extended to the next business day of court.
