HONORABLE KENNETH L. POPEJOY ELECTED AS CHIEF JUDGE

At their September 29, 2020 meeting, the Circuit Judges of the 18th Judicial Circuit, DuPage County, unanimously elected Circuit Judge Kenneth L. Popejoy to the position of Chief Judge. Judge Popejoy's term as Chief Judge will commence on December 7, 2020. Judge Popejoy will succeed Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin.

Kenneth L. Popejoy is a graduate of Chicago-Kent College of Law, Michigan State University and Glenbard West High School. He is the son of former DuPage County Bar Association President (1965), Charley Popejoy. He was appointed an Associate Judge in 1997 and was elected a Circuit Judge in 2004.
