

DuPage County Environmental Health, Safety and Property Loss Control Program Introduction

- I. This program sets forth a statement of policy and procedures on environmental, injury and property loss prevention administration.
- II. Policy
 - A. A comprehensive and continuing Environmental, Health, Safety and Property Loss Control program has been established to reduce and keep to a minimum, manpower, monetary, and resource losses resulting from unwanted occurrences. The principals, and procedures of the program will be applied to prevent injury or death, and to prevent loss or damage to property.
 - B. Safe operations will be a part of the day-to-day operations rather than a requirement to overcome. Safety cannot be viewed as an inconvenience or encumbrance to satisfactory job performance. Nothing we do is so important that it cannot be done safely.
 - C. It is mandatory, for the efficient and proper conduct of all work accomplished by or under the supervision of the DuPage County, that every practicable means be utilized by management and supervision to protect workers, property, equipment, and the public by effectively controlling incidents, fires, and occupational health hazards and providing and insuring the use of personnel protective equipment, facilities, and apparel as the hazards of work or activity require.
 - D. Injury and Property Loss Control is recognized and will be integrated into all activities and operational procedures. Integration of prevention measures in all activities and operational procedures is the basic concept of the DuPage County Environmental, Health, Safety and Property Loss Control Program.
