#### Mission

The mission of the DuPage County FOCUS unit is to enhance public safety and effectively aid in the recovery of court involved individuals facing first time felony drug offenses through intensive supervision, community-based treatment, and education.

#### Vision

#### We envision:

- A team approach headed by one dedicated judge and staff with expertise in all facets of substance use disorders.
- Clients being provided with probation support and being connected with community resources to assist with learning and strengthening pro-social behaviors and thinking to support obtaining sobriety, enhancing life skills, and preventing recidivism.
- Having the ultimate goal of individuals avoiding the negative consequences of incarceration and a felony on their criminal record.
- Our communities benefiting from a reduced recidivism rate and confidently investing in the criminal justice process.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

- 1. Must not have any previous felony convictions related to controlled substances.
- 2. Must plead guilty to or be found guilty of possession of a controlled substance pursuant to 720 ILCS 550/10, 720 ILCS 570/410, and 720 ILCS 646/70

### **Conditions:**

Conditions of FOCUS include, but are not limited to, appearing before the court as directed, in person contact with the probation department, drug testing, a substance abuse evaluation and any recommended treatment, and public service hours. The FOCUS reporting requirements are an attachment to this document.
