



SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT FOR THE EAGLE VALLEY TRAIL

only for sections owned and managed by Eagle County

Please note that several sections of the Eagle Valley Regional Trail are located within town boundaries and managed by Gypsum, Eagle, Avon and Vail. Those individual jurisdictions need to be contacted if you intend to use their trail sections. You are also responsible for contacting town police, Eagle County Sheriff, County Road and Bridge and Colorado Department of Transportation if using portions of local streets or highways.

For events involving gathering of over 499 persons, an Eagle County Special Use Permit process may apply. Please contact the Eagle County Planning Department at 970-328-8746 to determine applicability.

Special Event Organizers planning to utilize a section of the Region Trail system located in the county unincorporated area are required to abide by the following conditions:

- Check the trail route for obstacles or debris prior to the race.
- Do not use permanent spray paint on the trail if trying to show directions - use chalk spray or chalk only.
- Remove all signs, debris and articles from the event immediately after the event.
- Do not block or hinder other trails users in any area and particularly in congested or narrow trail sections.
- Do not set up aid stations in areas that block or hinder trail use or cause disturbance to the surrounding ground area.
- Event organizers will be responsible for all damage, refuse and other impacts associated with the event.
- Motor vehicles are not allowed on the trail system.
- Events must provide certificate of insurance naming *Eagle County, Colorado, its officers, agents and employees*, as additional insureds and naming the specific event date(s) being insured. The insurance shall insure against all claims, damages, losses or expenses arising out of, related to or resulting from the event or the use of the Facility (Eagle Valley Trail): Commercial General Liability with limits of liability not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate limits.
