

Eagle County Environmental Health Fee Schedule – Effective January 1, 2011

On-site wastewater treatment system (OWTS)* – New installation	\$800	Includes percolation test and a final inspection.
OWTS – Major repair	\$800	Includes percolation test and a final inspection.
OWTS – Minor repair	\$400	Includes final inspection.
OWTS – Emergency Use	\$150	
OWTS – Reinstatement of permit expired less than one year, no changes	\$100	
OWTS – Reinstatement of permit expired more than one year	\$400	
OWTS – Additional inspections	\$135	
OWTS – Systems contractor license, new	\$50	Includes testing.
OWTS – Systems contractor license, renewal	\$25	
OWTS – Cleaner license, new	\$50	Includes testing.
OWTS – Cleaner license, renewal	\$25	
Child Care inspections – Facilities requiring one inspection per year (day camps, pre-schools, and head start programs)	\$60	Invoiced annually.
Child Care inspections – Facilities requiring two inspections per year (including infants and toddlers)	\$120	Invoiced annually.
Child Care inspections – Facilities requiring one inspection every two years (after school programs)	\$60	Invoiced bi-annually.
Plan review application submittal fee, including child care facilities, food service establishments, and temporary/special event vendors	\$100	
Plan review	\$60/hour	Not to exceed \$580, payable at pre-operational inspection.
FS – Equipment plan review	\$100	
FS – Review of potential restaurant site	\$75	
FS – Temporary/special event vendor renewal, no changes to plan	\$25	
FS – Temporary/special event, Coordinator application	\$50	
FS – Temporary/special event inspection	\$20/booth	Paid by event coordinator upon completion of inspection, not to exceed \$180.

***On-site wastewater treatment system (OWTS) is the terminology Eagle County uses to describe what is traditionally referred to as an Individual Sewage Disposal System (ISDS).**
