Dear Julia:

For 2019, Eagle County has identified non-profit organizations that fill a critical service gap aligned with the County's strategic priorities. Your organization has been identified as a service partner for 2019, with \$97,500 allotted from Eagle County's portion of Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act funding (formerly referred to as Payment in Lieu of Taxes) (SRS), \$20,000 of which is specifically for Family Leadership Training Institute. Eagle County partners with the Eagle County School District and Roaring Fork School District to administer and distribute these SRS funds. School District staff will coordinate the distribution of SRS funding.

For 2019, Eagle County Government wishes to better understand the impact of SRS dollars in our communities. In order to be eligible for funding next year, please submit the attached reporting template by September 30, 2019. Eagle County staff will work with your organization to best determine reporting timeframes and metrics, so please reach out to the contact listed on the form as soon as possible. Additionally, Eagle County Board of Commissioners may request your participation in a work session following the submittal of your organization's performance reporting.
