



Town of Eastchester Movie Screening FAQ's



TICKETING

Where can I buy a ticket?

Tickets are available for purchase on Eventbrite and are \$25 per car. Please visit:

All tickets must be purchased online. Day of sale tickets (pending availability) must still be purchased online. A digital ticket will be emailed to you upon completion of your purchase. Please be aware that this event is for residents only and proof of residency will be asked for at the event at check in.

Does each person need their own ticket?

No, only one ticket is required per vehicle. Larger families that need to take two cars will need to purchase two tickets.

Is there a limit on the number of attendees per vehicle?

Yes, your ticket allows you to bring as many people as your car can safely accommodate. The number of passengers must not exceed the number of safety belts/seats in your vehicle.

What if the weather is bad?

If it is lightly raining the event will still be on. In the event of any heavy rain, thunderstorms, or snow storms the event will be postponed to the rain/makeup date which is the following day, Saturday, November 21.

The recreation staff will monitor the weather all day and if it needs to be postponed all ticket holders will receive an email about the cancellation. If both the original date and the makeup date are cancelled all ticket holders will be refunded.

ARRIVAL

Where is the event taking place?

The event will take place in the parking lot at Lake Isle Country Club which is located at 660 White Plains Road, Eastchester, NY 10709.

When can I arrive?

The lot will open 45 minutes prior to show time. Parking spots will be assigned on a first come, first serve bases. **Please be aware that SUVs and oversized vehicles will be directed towards the back of the lot.**

Do I need to wear a mask?

Yes, upon entering the driver and passengers must show that they have their own mask. Masks will be required at ticket check-in and anytime a guest leaves their car.

How will my ticket be taken?

All tickets will be checked upon entry. One ticket equals one car. **Proof of residency is required when entering (driver's license or utility bill).**

PARKING

How do I know where to park?

Vehicles will be directed by the event staff on where to park. **Please be aware that oversized vehicles will be directed towards the back to ensure optimal viewing experience for all guests.**

What should I do about my headlights?

Please dim your headlights before pulling into the parking lot and turn off all lights (including interior lights) before the film starts.

Can I bring lawn chairs and watch outside of my car?

Yes, but if you decide to do that you must have a mask on at all-times. Cars will be spaced apart so that people can view the movie outside of their car if they choose. For those who have pickup trucks, sitting in the bed of the truck is prohibited. Please be aware that you need to arrive in a car. Walk-ins are not allowed.

VEHICLE TYPES

What types of vehicles are NOT allowed?

Motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, scooters, RVs, limousines are strictly prohibited. In addition, all unenclosed vehicles will also be prohibited.

DURING THE EVENT

Can I leave my vehicle during the event?

Yes, guests can leave to go to the restroom or sit outside in a lawn chair that they have brought to watch the movie. Please keep in mind that anyone who leaves their car must have a mask on at all times. No exceptions.

Can I keep the car engine idling?

Please refrain from idling our engine. If you need to periodically start your car to keep your battery charged, please limit the amount of time you are idling. Also, please be aware that any lights in your car will be a distraction to others.

How will I hear the movie?

All films are broadcast and can be heard in your vehicle using your FM radio. The specific channel will be listed on the screen beforehand. If your vehicle does not have a radio it is recommended that you bring one.

Can I leave my car to socialize with other movie goers?

As a safety precaution we ask that each family stays in their designated parking space for the duration of the movie.

MISCELLANEOUS

Are pets/dogs allowed into the screening?

Only service animals are allowed and must be kept on a leash at all times.

Are there restrooms available?

Yes, a temporary restroom will be available onsite. However, it's encouraged to use the restroom before the arriving. All guests are expected to practice social distancing while waiting in line for the restroom.
