Considerable knowledge of and skills in the application of nursing theory, practices, principles and techniques employed in the field of public health and related programs; considerable knowledge of and ability to apply the principles and practices of public health; considerable knowledge of available resources and organizations and the ability to coordinate these as needed; general knowledge of current social and economic problems relating to public health. Ability to deal tactfully with others and to exercise good judgment in appraising situation and making decisions; ability to secure the cooperation of clients, to elicit needed information, and to maintain effective working relationships; ability to record accurately services rendered and to interpret and explain records, reports, and medical instructions.

Graduation from a four year college or university with a BS Degree in Nursing which includes a public health nursing rotation and one year of Public Health experience; or graduation from an accredited school of nursing and two years of professional nursing experience including one year in public health; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Current R.N. Licensure by NC Board of Nursing. BSN required.

Valid North Carolina driver's license, pre-employment drug testing and background check required.
